WHEREAS, The Human Resources Department recommends a base wage increase of approximately 13% at top step for the Military & Veterans Affairs Officer classification based on the internal analysis; and

WHEREAS, this action requires the Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution No. 98-394 Appendix A to be amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolved to approve the following:
