CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE NORTHERN SALINAS VALLEY MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

- (a) The Political Reform Act of 1974, Government Code Sections 81000, et. seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard model Conflict of Interest Code, which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings. Therefore, the terms of 2 cal. Code of Regis. section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, along with the attached Appendix in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Northern Salimas Valley Mosuqito Abatement District.
- (b) Pursuant to Government Code section 81008 and 2 Cal. Code of Regis. section 18730 (b) (4), all designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with their agency. Upon receipt of the statement of the Northern Salinas Valley Mosquito Abatement District, the agency shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of the statement to the code reviewing body. Statements for all other designated employees shall be retained by the agency, which shall make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction.

EXHIBIT B: DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

General Provisions

When a member, officer, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose investments and sources of income, he or she shall disclose investments in business entities and sources of income which do business in the jurisdiction, plan to do business in the jurisdiction, or have done business to in the jurisdiction within the past two years. In addition to other activities, a business entity is doing business within the jurisdiction if it owns real property within the jurisdiction.

When a designated member, officer, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose sources of income, he or she shall disclose gifts received from donors located inside as well as outside the jurisdiction.

When a designated member, office, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose interests in real property, he or she shall disclose the type of real property described below, if it is located in whole or in part within, or not more than two miles outside of the boundaries of the jurisdiction, or within two miles of any land owned or used by the Northern-Salinas Valley Mosquito Abatement District.

When a designated member, officer, or employee who holds a designated position is required to disclose business position, he or she shall disclose positions in business entities that do business in the jurisdiction, plan to do business in the jurisdiction, or have done business in the jurisdiction within the past two years.

For purposes of this Conflict of Interest Code, the jurisdiction of the Northern Salinas Valley Mosquito Abatement District is the 458 square miles of northern Monterey County.

Disclosure Category 1:

A member, officer, or employee holding a position assigned to Disclosure Category 1 shall, in the manner described above, report:

All investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income in the jurisdiction;

Interests in real property in the jurisdiction, which were acquired by, leased, or otherwise used by the Northern Salinas Valley Mosquito Abatement District;

His or her status as director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holder of a management position in any business entity in the jurisdiction.
