WHEREAS , the Program was awarded a grant to assist local commercial cannabis operators with transitioning from provisional to permanent state licensure. The Program was informed of the award on January 5, 2022, and the grant agreement was executed on January 27, 2022; and
WHEREAS , this action results in a financial commitment of \$1,389,628 in the adopted FY 2021-22 Budget, which is offset by grant revenues from the Department of Cannabis Control.
