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Hi Son,

We don't ordinarily comment on single-family residential projects as these projects don't have significant air quality impacts. Neither do we expect that the ordinary periodic use of a residential 3-car garage would expose sensitive receptors to substantial pollutant concentrations or cause odors which adversely affect a significant number of people. Unless there is some other use of the garage, such as operating a commercial body shop, I don't see that there is a valid excess emissions issue. Also, with the trend toward increased electric vehicle use, emissions will likely cease altogether.

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
