Adopt a resolution Honoring Nadia Mendoza as a Monterey County Military and Veterans Affairs Advisory Commission's Veteran of the Year for 2022

WHEREAS, Each year, the County of Monterey and the Monterey County Veterans Services Advisory Commission honors those who have made a significant contribution to their communities, are strong motivators, have demonstrated extraordinary professional competence, and are role models for veterans and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, The Monterey County Military and Veterans Services Advisory Commission is honored to recognize Nadia Mendoza as a 2022 Veteran of The Year; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza started her career in 1998 right after high school as an active duty member of the United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza was a Logistician and two-year member of the Base Honor Guard at Maxwell Air Force Base in Montgomery, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza was deployed a total of nine times to multiple hostile environments which included Iraq, Kuwait, Qatar and Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, During Nadia Mendoza's many deployments and her work ethic, dedication, and service before self, she assisted in the completion of multiple critical missions across numerous Middle East regions; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza's service medals are the Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza led an extraordinary 20-year career, one which has shaped her into the woman she is today. She retired in March 2018 after an outstanding 20 years in the United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS, Nadia Mendoza continues to support fellow veterans. Every year she volunteers her time and contributes as an active member of the Salinas Veterans Day Parade Committee, where she serves as their Finance Officer.
