WHEREAS, the County is required or has agreed to make appointments to various non-County entities such as special districts and joint powers authorities; and,

WHEREAS, historically, the appointments to such committees and non-County entities have been annually upon recommendation of the incoming Chairperson of the Board and vote of the full Board; and,

WHEREAS, the procedure for appointments has not been formally established, and was last addressed by the Board in 2010; and,

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary and appropriate for the Board to consider adopting a Board Policy addressing Board standing and ad hoc committees, and non-County entities to which the Board makes appointments, and the process for making such appointments; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct.
- 2. Board Policy No. G-10, attached hereto, is approved and adopted, and ordered included in the Board Policy Manual.
- 3. The County Administrative Officer, County Counsel and Clerk of the Board are directed to take such other necessary or appropriate actions to implement the intent and purposes of this resolution.
