Economic Development Committee

Purpose:

To advise the Board of Supervisors on appropriate economic development policies, programs and activities to ensure a Countywide perspective in support of a diversified economy, higher paying jobs and expanded revenue base for local government services, while preserving and protecting the County's agricultural, tourism and education economic base in collaboration with cities.

Membership:

1. The Committee shall consist of fourteen (14) members:
2. Two (2) Members of the Board of Supervisors; and
3. A. One (1) industry leader from each of the following twelve (12) economic sectors:
 1. Micro Business
 2. Minority Owned Business
 3. Higher Education
 4. Finance
 5. Healthcare
 6. Labor
 7. Tourism
 8. Climate and Clean Energy
 9. Construction
 10. Non-profit or Community Member
 11. Agriculture
 12. Research and Development

Economic Development Committee

Criteria to be considered in nominating individuals to serve as committee members shall include, but not be limited to:

- Background and skills needed on the committee
- Resident, employed in, or owns a business in Monterey County
- Available and willing to attend monthly and other Committee meetings and actively participate on subcommittees as necessary
- History of community leadership
- Executive experience in one or more large and complex organizations
- Skills related to strategic planning
- At least one of the committee members shall possess environmental credentials
- Possess a general understanding of Governing for Racial Equity principles and is willing to participate in discussions of equity principles.
