### **Economic Development Committee**

#### Purpose:

To advise the Board of Supervisors on appropriate economic development policies, programs and activities to ensure a Countywide perspective in support of a diversified economy, higher paying jobs and expanded revenue base for local government services, while preserving and protecting the County's agricultural, tourism and education economic base in collaboration with cities. <u>Membership:</u>

- 1. The Committee shall consist of fourteen (14) members:
- 2. Two (2) Members of the Board of Supervisors; and
- 3. A. One (1) industry leader from each of the following twelve (12) economic sectors:
  - 1. Micro Business
  - 2. Minority Owned Business
  - 3. Higher Education
  - 4. Finance
  - 5. Healthcare
  - 6. Labor
  - 7. Tourism
  - 8. Climate and Clean Energy
  - 9. Construction
  - 10. Non-profit or Community Member
  - 11. Agriculture
  - 12. Research and Development

### **Economic Development Committee**

Criteria to be considered in nominating individuals to serve as committee members shall include, but not be limited to:

- Background and skills needed on the committee
- Resident, employed in, or owns a business in Monterey County
- Available and willing to attend monthly and other Committee meetings and actively participate on subcommittees as necessary
- History of community leadership
- Executive experience in one or more large and complex organizations
- Skills related to strategic planning
- At least one of the committee members shall possess environmental credentials
- Possess a general understanding of Governing for Racial Equity principles and is willing to participate in discussions of equity principles.
