Support the Board of Supervisors authorizing and directing the Auditor-Controller to amend FY 2023-24 Adopted Budget for County Service Area 17- Tierra Grande to increase appropriations to fund completion of an Engineer's Report/Prop 218 election and drainage improvements and amend FY 2023-24 Adopted Budget for County Service Area 25- Carmel Valley Golf and Country Club to increase appropriations to fund engineering design services for drainage improvements.
5. Support adopting a resolution to:
 - a.  - b. Support authorizing and directing the Auditor-Controller to amend the Sheriff's FY 2023-24 Adopted Budget (001-2300-SHE003-8273) by increasing appropriations and estimated revenues \$10,950, financed by a PRISM and property grant; and
 - c. Support authorizing the Contracts and Purchasing Officer or their designee to execute a non-standard agreement with Flock Group Inc., dba Flock Safety, in an amount not to exceed \$19,950, for cameras to be erected at Government Center parking lots, effective November 1, 2023 to October 31, 2025.
