DEPARTMENT UPDATES

COP provided verbal updates on the following items:

a. <u>E-Bike Ordinance</u>

COP Flores reported that staff is working on two versions of the draft ordinance: limiting class 1 & 2 e-bikes to a 20mph limit and all electric transportation modalities to a 20mph limit.

b. Status of Bilingual Fee Waiver

COP Flores reported the Fee waiver has been translated into Spanish. The Facility Use Application will also be translated to Spanish soon. COP Flores informed Commissioners that the Parks reservation system. CivicRec does not translate to Spanish and is only programmed in English.

c. <u>Public Outreach/Engagement Strategies</u>

COP Flores reported his efforts in meeting with vendors to increase Monterey County Parks recognition. To increase off-season visits, Lake Nacimiento has promotional events with special rates that have been approved by Public Works, Facilities and Parks Director Ishii according to Monterey County Code 14.12. A fee resolution will be provided to the Board of Supervisors in the Spring for approval.

d. Manzanita Park Fuel Reduction Project

COP Flores reported that the Calfire Gabilan Crew completed seven days of vegetation/fuel reduction work on the perimeter road surrounding the sports complex. COP Flores stated they will be working with Calfire Gabilan Crew again to clear some of the equestrian and single-track trails.

Chair Stracke inquired about the possibility in creating an area at Manzanita Park for a disc golf course. COP Flores informed the commission that due to the park being operated by the North County Youth Recreation Association (NCYRA) and that the surrounding open space areas managed by Parks is heavily wooded, a disc golf course is not recommended.

It is recommended that the Monterey County Parks Commission appoint a Parks Commission Chair and Vice Chair for the 2024 calendar year; consider extending 2023 Chair tenure to 2024 calendar year.

SUMMARY:

The Monterey County Parks Commission Bylaws, adopted by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors on June 8, 2021, provide for the appointment of a Commission Chair and Vice Chair at the first meeting of the Commission each calendar year.

Section V Officers and Officer Duties states:

The Commission shall appoint a Chair and Vice Chair during the Commission's first meeting of each calendar year. The officers will be appointed on a rotating basis following the numerical order of the Supervisorial districts. The Supervisor serving on the Commission is excluded from the officer rotation.

For Calendar Year 2023, the Parks Commissioner from District 4 served as Chair and the Parks Commissioner from District 5 served as Vice Chair. Due to canceled meetings and an abbreviated time as Chair, Commissioner Stracke is requesting to remain in the position through 2024. Staff has conferred with County Counsel and while the by-laws state that a rotational schedule is to be adhered to, the Commission may take action and allow the existing officers to serve for additional time.
