Adopt Resolution recognizing Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District on its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

**WHEREAS,** in May 1971, a grassroots effort began to collect 5,000 signatures to place consideration of an open space district on the November ballot as Measure A; and

**WHEREAS**, the voters of Monterey County approved the measure which created the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District (MPRPD) in the November election of 1972; and

**WHEREAS,** MPRPD has as its mission to acquire and maintain open space for preservation and use, working with partners and the community, for public benefit, enjoyment and environmental protection; and

WHEREAS, MPRPD's current boundaries cover over 500 square miles and include the seven incorporated cities on the Monterey Peninsula, Carmel Valley, Pebble Beach and the Big Sur Coast, and within the District protects approximately 14,000 acres of open space; and

**WHEREAS**, MPRPD connects the public with parks and open space by encouraging life-long learning and appreciation of the natural and cultural resources within our community; and

**WHEREAS**, it is a milestone accomplishment for MPRPD to be celebrating fifty-years since its formation as approved by the voters within Monterey County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County and all residents thereof, do hereby recognize Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District on its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.
