As mentioned in the pre-bid meeting, we would like to clearly understand how Monterey county would like to see the revenue focus of an offer where one vendor combines commissary and food service. To assist with this question, please consider the following example:

- A 1,000-bed facility evaluates a commissary proposal offering 25% commission on 1mil. annual commissionable sales equaling a net 250K of annual commissary revenue.
- The same facility evaluates a separate proposal for food service at a price per meal of \$2.00 resulting in a cost to the county of \$2.19mil.

The county knows the pricing of many combined food service and commissary contracts have been structured in a manner that would allocate value from the separate services in one specific direction. Again, in considering the above example:

- a. County may choose to split the total commissary commission amount leaving 10% 100K in place and then applies the remaining 15%, 150K towards subsidization of the price per meal down, to \$1.863 or \$2.04mil.
- b. The county may choose to let food pricing remain whole and maximize commissary commission so retains the whole 250K in the commissary fund.
- c. County may choose to fix commissary commission amount at __% and instead instructs the vendor to reduce the retail inmate pricing on the commissary items by a percentage (or sometimes all) of the commission dollars.
- d. County requires vendors bid completely stand alone offers for each service and evaluates the offers against the county's best interests. A verbal award is made to the vendor(s) with the highest score, and the county then enters into contract negotiations at which point, the county can objectively evaluate known revenue and determine how it prefers to allocate.

Please note, (as also stated in the pre-bid meeting) we have seen all of these scenarios played out and while we are not advocating for any particular one, we just need to understand how the county would like to proceed?
