Amendment No. 1 to Memorandum of Understanding by and between the County of Monterey and the California Department of Public Health

This Amendment is made to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in accordance with Section 131090 of the Health and Safety Code, CDPH is authorized to establish the California Epidemiologic Investigation Service (Cal-EIS) Fellowship Program (Fellowship) by and between California Department of Public Health, hereinafter "CONTRACTOR", and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "County".

WHEREAS, the County and Contractor entered into an agreement on the sixth day of June 2023 which was executed on June 30, 2023, for the term of July 3, 2023, to June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County and CONTRACTOR wish to amend the MOU to add an additional Fellow, Katherine Velasco, with the same goals and activities set forth in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

NOW THEREFORE, the County and CONTRACTOR hereby agree to amend the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in the following manner:

- 1. Section 3, shall be amended as follows: "Regents of the University of California, Davis (UCD) will provide wages and reimbursement comparable to a stipend of \$55,000 per fellow, for the term July 3, 2023, to June 30, 2024; health insurance included, along with allocations for travel and training expenses for the CDPH Fellows who are accepted by CDPH and the County into the Cal-EIS Fellowship appointment. The training should lead to completion of competencies established by CDPH, Cal-EIS, and the County.
- 2. Section 4 shall be amended as follows: "The Goals and activities of the assigned fellows, Matthew Colbert and Katherine Velasco", all remaining terms, and conditions, shall remain the same and unchanged.
- 3. All references to the term "fellow" shall be modified to state "fellows" throughout the MOU.
- 4. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) are unchanged and unaffected by this AMENDMENT and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the Memorandum.
- 5. A copy of this AMENDMENT shall be attached to the original AGREEMENT dated June 30, 2023.
