County of Monterey Draft Housing Element Sixth Cycle Update is available for public review!

The Housing Element will be available for a 30-day public review period beginning Monday, May 6, 2024, and ending Friday, June 6, 2024.

The County of Monterey Housing and Community Development Department staff has officially released the Draft Housing Element Sixth Cycle (2023-2031) Update for public review and comment.

Housing Element Overview:

The Draft Housing Element is how the County of Monterey plans to meet existing and future housing needs of its residents for various income levels that live in the unincorporated Monterey County. The Draft Housing Element includes goals, policies, programs, and strategies to accommodate housing for the County's expected population growth, provide opportunities for new housing, and preserve existing affordable housing stock. As a core component of the County's General Plan, the Housing Element must be consistent with the other elements of the General Plan. The Draft Housing Element Sixth Cycle Update covers the eight-year planning period from 2023-2031 and must be adopted by the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors. The State Department of Housing and Community Development Department is required to review the Draft Housing Element after conclusion of the 30-day public review period.
