Five-Year CIP

- Includes projects that:
 - \$100,000+
 - Provide long-term assets
 - Maintain and/or improve the County's infrastructure
- Budget and a Plan:
 - Budget: Year 1 is financially constrained and will become part of the annual operating budget when approved.
 - Plan: Years 2 through 5 are a plan of priorities.
- Updated annually based on current priorities and funding.

April

Board reviews unfunded project requests and CIC recommendations, provides direction to CAO Budget Office.



Budget Committee

May:

Recommended funding for CIC-recommended unfunded project priorities.



Budget Adoption

June

Board adopts budget and CIP.

March

CIC reviews draft CIP and makes recommendations to the Board on unfunded project priorities.



Apr-May

CAO Budget Office allocates available funding to Board priority projects.
