#### **Corrective Action Plan (CAP) Updates**

- FCS must complete 27 corrective actions by November 30, 2024.
- As of February 2024, FCS has completed 19 corrective actions.
- Since the last report, more detail has been provided in the CAP, which has increased the total number of action items from 21 to 27.
- FCS has also began an robust continuous quality improvement (CQI) efforts to ensure continued improvement efforts around both practices and policies



# **CAP Immediate Action Steps**

January 2024 – July 2024

- Social workers receive consistent and regular supervision
- Update Emergency Response policies
  - Ensure timely closure of referrals
- Develop Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) policy



# **CAP Long-Term Action Steps**

August 2024 – November 2024


- Train staff on standards for evaluating out referrals
- Increase staff utilization of Safe Measures for caseload management
- Develop procedures for re-distributing caseloads
- Develop rotation schedule for hotline staff
- Procedures for timely closure of referrals that are evaluated out
- Ensure completion of the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) assessment tool.
- Build relationships with community partners
- Close out all Emergency Response referrals



#### Intake Data

January 2024

- FCS received 376 reports of suspected child abuse/neglect
- 157 of those referrals required an in-person investigation
- There are 225 open referrals in the Intake Unit.






# **Emergency Response Units**

January 2024

Out of 157 referrals that required in-person investigation, 65 required an immediate response.





## **Total Open Referrals**

January 2023 – January 2024

• As of January 31, 2024, there were 1159 open referrals in both Intake and ER





# Staffing

- Ongoing Efforts
- Under filling
- Training in the field to experience a day in the life of a social worker
- Social Worker desire to engage with families while in chaos and the amount of time that it takes
- When FCS entered into the CAP in December 2022, the agency had 27 social worker and social work supervisor vacancies. As of February 7, 2024, FCS now has only 9 vacancies.
