## AMENDMENT No. 2 TO PARAMEDIC SERVICE PROVIDER AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND CITY OF MONTEREY

**THIS AMENDMENT No. 2** is made to the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement ("AGREEMENT") by and between the City of Monterey hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER," and the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California, acting through its Emergency Medical Services Agency (EMSA), hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY."

WHEREAS, on or about September 4, 2018, COUNTY and PROVIDER entered into an AGREEMENT for the provision of paramedic services in the County of Monterey for a period from September 4, 2018 to January 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 13, 2020, COUNTY and PROVIDER executed Amendment No. 1 ("AMENDMENT No. 1") to extend the term of the AGREEMENT for two (2) years, for the period from January 31, 2020 to January 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, COUNTY and PROVIDER wish to amend the AGREEMENT to extend the AGREEMENT for a period of five (5) years to January 31, 2027; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, COUNTY and PROVIDER hereby agree to amend the AGREEMENT in the following manner:

- 1. Section 1 of Term of Agreement shall be amended by removing "Once signed by the authorized representatives for all parties, this agreement becomes effective at 8:00 a.m. on September 4, 2018 and shall continue until the end of the next Monterey County Operating Area Ambulance 911 Provider Contract Cycle on January 31, 2022," and replacing it with "Once signed by the authorized representatives for all parties, this agreement becomes effective at 8:00 a.m. on September 4, 2018 and shall continue until the authorized representatives for all parties, this agreement becomes effective at 8:00 a.m. on September 4, 2018 and shall continue until January 31, 2027."
- 2. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the AGREEMENT and AMENDMENT No. 1 are unchanged and unaffected by this AMENDMENT No. 2 and shall continue in full force and effect.
- 3. A copy of AMENDMENT No. 2 shall be attached to the original AGREEMENT dated September 4, 2018 and shall be incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the AGREEMENT.
