

# Treasurer-Tax Collector

Augmentation Request May 31, 2023

Requesting a one-time augmentation of \$135,000 to replace an end-of life payment processing machine & \$116,057 to restore Cannabis Program cuts.

### Remittance Payment Processing Machines

- Used to process property tax payments and transmit electronic deposits to the bank for ALL county deposits
- Purchased over a decade ago
- Both machines recently crashed and are completely out of service
- Sent to surplus.



### **Remaining Processor**

- Additional capabilities that include mail extraction & scanning
- Has also reached end of life
- Vendor will no longer maintain or service this machine
- Vendor is willing to offer a trade-in allowance with the purchase of a new machine



A new remittance processor is needed to sustain the ability to efficiently & timely process large volumes of tax payments, scan taxpayer correspondence and make electronic bank deposits

### Alternatives

#### Manual Processing

- Reallocate staff from customer service to payment processing
- Procure additional low volume desktop processors
- Revert to manual bank deposits

### Fully Outsource

- Completely outsource all payment processing functions
- Use low volume desktop processors
- Revert to manual bank deposits



## Concerns with Alternatives

- Loss of revenue due to delayed processing & bank deposits
  - At today's interest rates THIS IS SIGNIFICANT
- Increased cost for banking deposit services
- Increased cost for armored car services
- Decrease in taxpayer satisfaction
- Loss of document scanning ability
- Inefficient use of staff resources
- Overuse of equipment intended for low volume processing
- Potential increase in worker injuries due to prolonged use of low volume machines that are not ergonomic
- Lack of processing redundancies & disaster recovery tools.
- Potential security concerns

Requesting restoration of cannabis program cuts \$116,057

### Reductions to Program

### Staff & Indirect Costs \$105,263

- ♦ Employee Costs:
  - Employees & support staff not budgeted in cannabis but who work on cannabis program:
    \$ 96,456
  - ♦ Overhead Costs: \$8,807

Services & Supplies - Eliminated

\$10,794

- ♦ Telephones
- ♦ Insurance
- ♦ Mail handling & postage
- ♦ ERP charges
- ♦ Office supplies
- ♦ Cannabis currency counter maintenance
- ♦ HDL software tax system annual cost
- ♦ Security for lobby during cannabis payments
- ♦ Armored car services
- ♦ Banking charges & cash handling fees

Restore a portion of Staff & Indirect Costs ~ \$52,632

> Restore all Services & Supplies ~ \$10,794

> > TOTAL ~ \$63,426

## Recommendation

Strategic Initiative – Efficient & Effective Government Operations

Promote an organization that practices efficient and effective resource management and is recognized for responsiveness, strong customer orientation, accountability and transparency.



#### Recommendation

Grant the Treasurer-Tax Collector a \$135,000 augmentation request to purchase a new payment processor/scanner thereby maintaining cost effective, timely and efficient payment processing and banking deposits.

#### AND

Restore a minimum of \$63,426 to the Treasurer-Tax Collector for Cannabis Program staff costs and services & supplies.

Revisit Cannabis Tax Revenues at mid-year and entertain additional augmentations should program revenues increase
