SUBJECT: Approve amendments to conflict of interest code of the County Administrative Office of Monterey County	
DEPARTMENT: COUNTY COUNSEL	

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors, as code reviewing body, approve and order the proposed amendments to the conflict of interest code of the County Administrative Office of Monterey County, a copy of which is attached hereto.

SUMMARY:

Following adoption of the County's budget on June 29, 2010 and biennial review of its conflict of interest code as required by Government Code section 87306.5, the County Administrative Office amended its conflict of interest code to update its designated positions.

DISCUSSION:

Amendments to local agency conflict of interest code are authorized by section 87306 of the Government Code whenever changes are required by changed circumstances, by creation or deletion of designated positions, or by changes in the duty of such positions. The proposed code as amended is lawful under the Political Reform Act of 1974.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

No other agency involvement exists.

FINANCING:

There is no fiscal impact upon the County of Monterey as a result of the proposed amendments.
