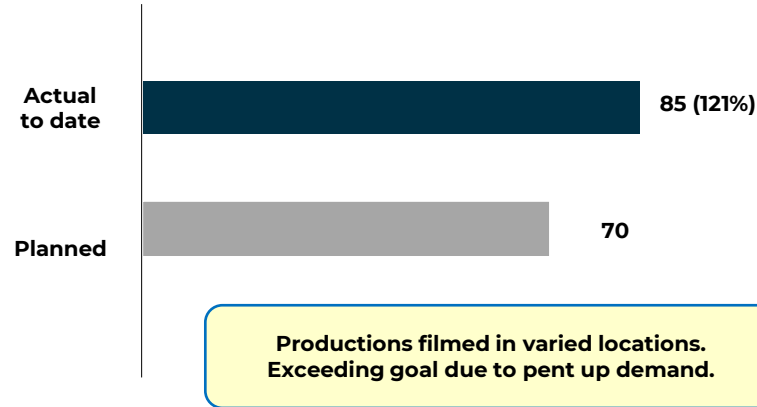

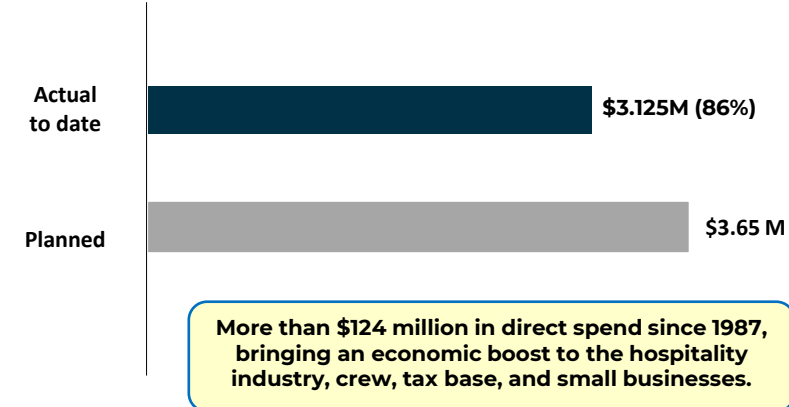


DSA Performance Metrics = 2021-22

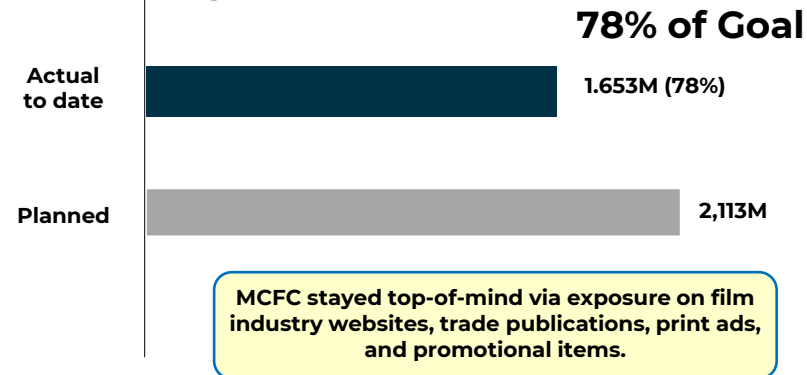
Film Productions —121% of Goal



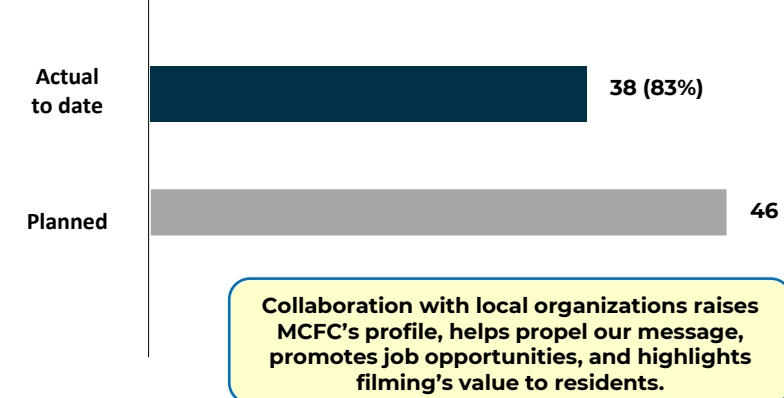
Total Local Spend — 86% of Goal

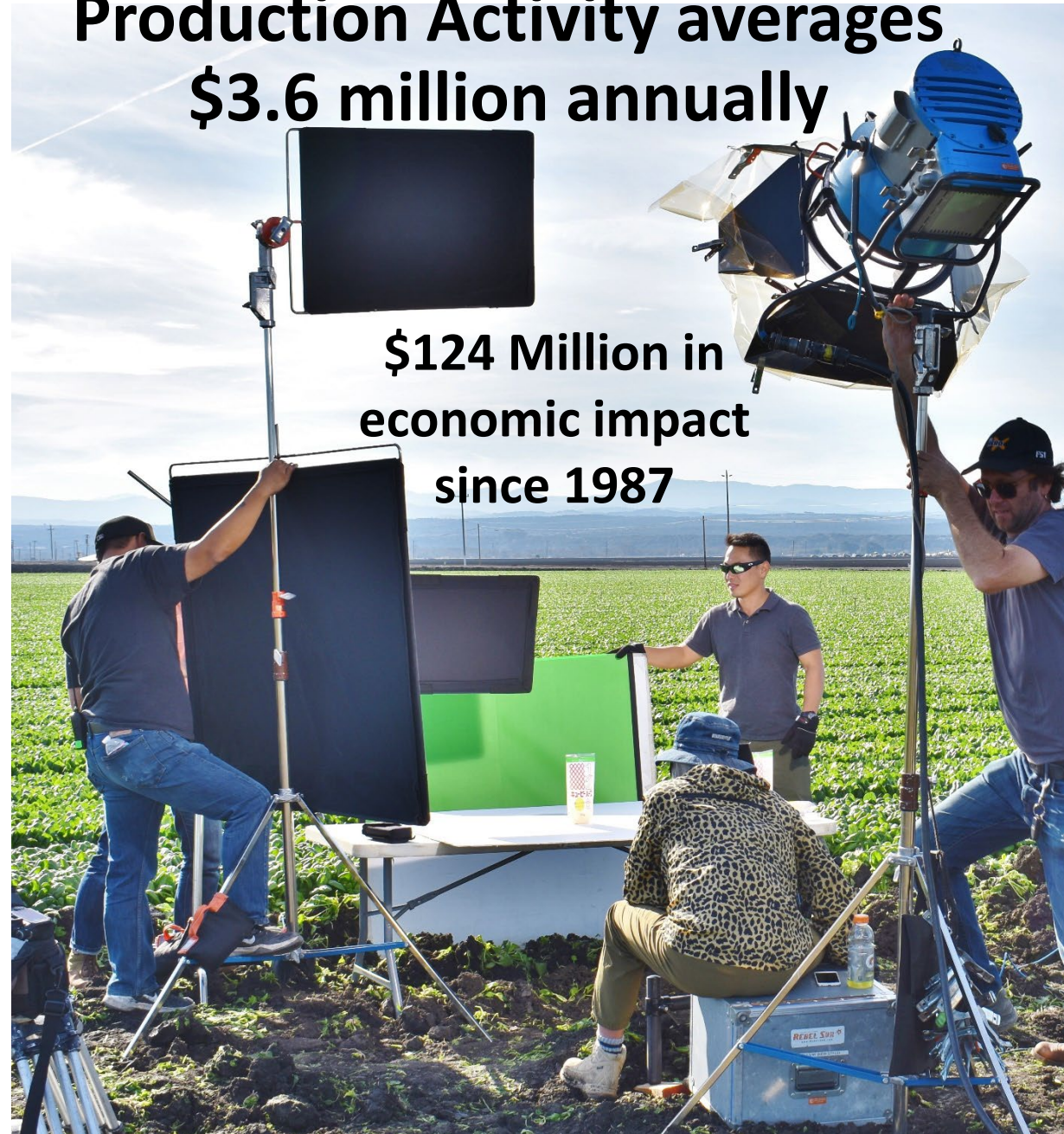

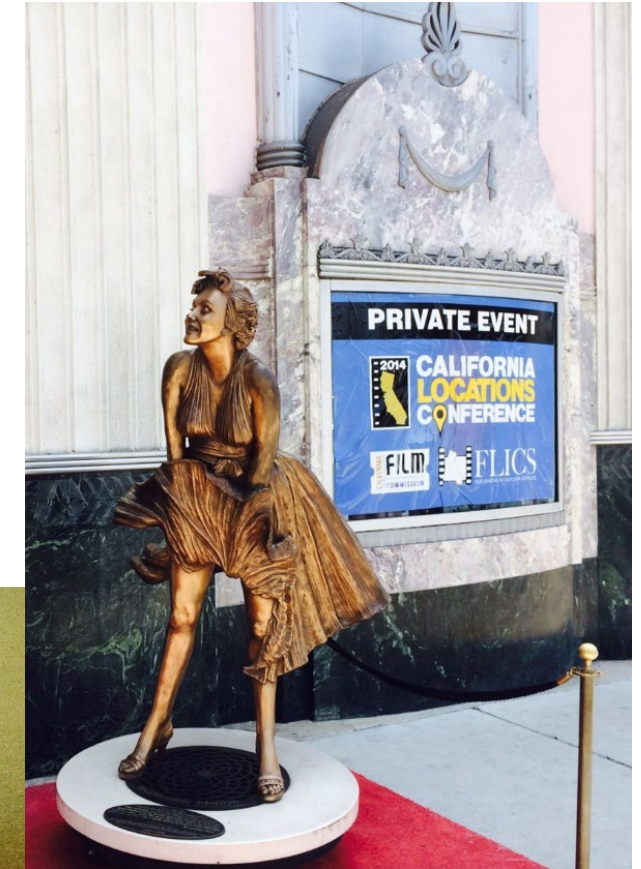
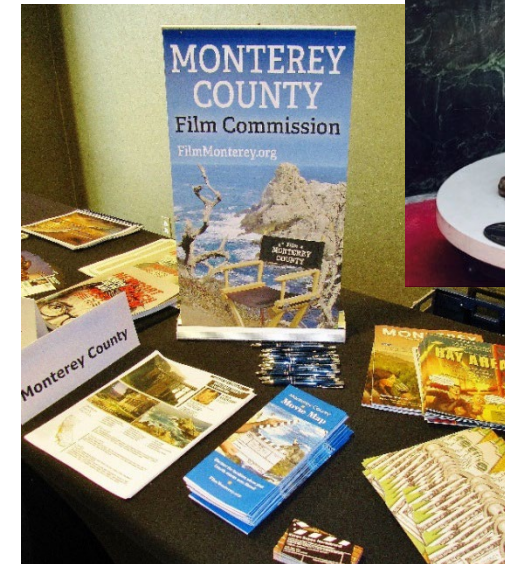
CA Film Incentive Program: \$330 million annually to retain film production dollars in the state



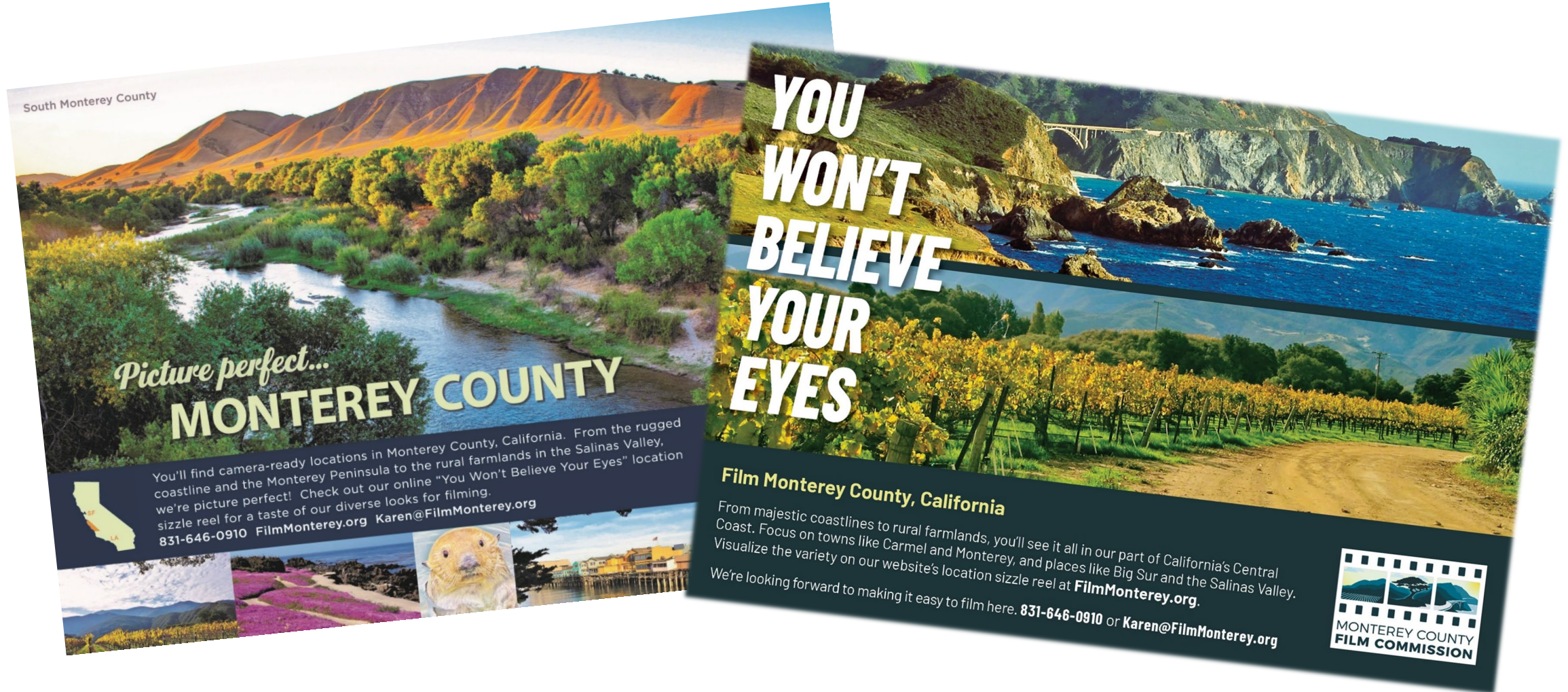
- ★ Most entertainment jobs in California are created by small businesses with fewer than ten employees
