### Board Order

Upon motion of Supervisor Potter, seconded by Supervisor Armenta and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

Approved amendments to the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Fiscal Year 2016-17 Adopted Budget to support new County functions for issuance of business licenses and collection of taxes for commercial cannabis businesses operating in unincorporated Monterey County, as follows:

- a. Increased allocated positions to add one Management Analyst III, one Accountant III, and one Accounting Technician in Property Tax unit 1170-TRE001-8263;
- b. Increased FY 2016-17 estimated revenue and appropriations by \$228,491 in Treasurer-Tax Collector - Property Tax budget 1170-TRE001-8263 to fund salaries and benefits for new positions (\$120,353), equipment, services and supplies (\$34,323), and facility security enhancements to the County Treasury (\$73,815) (4/5th vote required);
- c. Directed the County Administrative Office to incorporate approved changes in the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Adopted Budget and the Human Resources Department to implement approved changes in the Advantage HRM System; and
- d. Authorized the Auditor-Controller to increase estimated revenue and appropriations by \$228,491 in Treasurer-Tax Collector - Property Tax budget 1170-TRE001-8263 (4/5th vote required)
