

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Health Department is contracted to provide Sexual Assault Forensic Exam Services;

WHEREAS, the Sexual Assault Forensic Exam is a specialized field requiring advanced training of medical practitioners in adult and pediatric forensic exams;

WHEREAS, the addition of per diem language allowing for pro-rated compensation for examiners who work less than a twenty-four (24) hour shift would allow the Department more flexibility in recruiting qualified Examiners and allow Examiners to split a shift;

WHEREAS, the monthly SART coalition meeting provides necessary information to examiners regarding peer review and ensures quality assurance and providing compensation will increase attendance;

WHEREAS, the actions require the Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution No. 98-394, Section A.9.1 and Section A.48.3 to be amended; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey as follows:

- a. Section A.9.1 Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner – Per diem Standby Pay, of Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution No. 98-394, is amended as indicated below:

A.9.1.A Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner – Per Diem Standby Pay Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners – Per Diem who are placed on standby duty in accordance with the rules and procedures established by the County for such duty shall be paid at the rate of \$240 dollars per 24-hour shift (0 to 2400). Sexual Assault Forensic Examiners-Per Diem who work less than a 24-hour shift shall have their rate pro-rated for partial shifts.

- b. Section A.48.3 Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner – Per diem Language, of Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution No. 98-394, is amended as indicated below;

A.48.3 Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner – Per Diem Trainee and Clinically Competent Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner-Per Diem shall attend a once a month-two (2) hour SART coalition meeting and shall be paid \$50 dollars per hour, for a total of \$100.

Upon proof of completion of training provided by California Clinical Forensic Medical Training Center (CCFMTC) or other pre-approved provider, SAFE's shall be eligible for reimbursement for such training up to the following amounts:

- \$500 for training - Conducting Adult Examinations
- \$500 for training - Conducting Pediatric Examinations.

c. The Human Resources Department is authorized to implement these changes.


