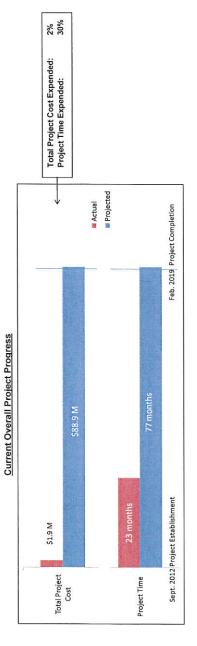
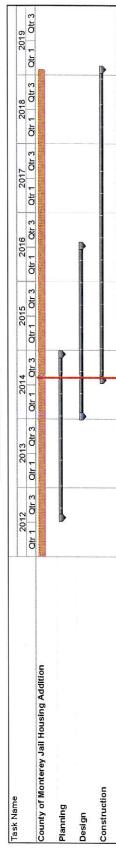

	PROJECT CHRONOLOGY TO DATE
07/30/2014	State Public Works Board approved Revised Project Cost, Scope, & Schedule. The revised scope increases the size of the housing area from four two-tier housing units to eight two-tier housing units, providing approximately 280 double-occupancy and 16 single-occupancy cells for a total of 576 beds. Housing area will include day rooms; control rooms; recreation yards; and program, treatment, interview, and storage space. A support area will provide visitation space; central control room; sallyport; interview rooms; training, storage, staff support, and administrative space. Due to decreased site availability, staff/visitor parking is reduced and existing parking areas utilized. Associated increased costs of \$48,752,000, brings new total estimated Project cost to \$88,900,000.
06/26/2014	Draft Jail Housing Addition Environmental Impact Report transmitted to State Clearing house. Public review-comment period ends August 13, 2014.
02/11/2014	Board of Supervisors (BOS) approved recommendations to provide clarification of the funding source for the required additional minimum matching funds in the amount of \$4,867,222 from the General Fund Capital Project Assignment (Account 3123); transfer the previously approved matching fund remaining balance, \$3,074,698, to Account 3123, bringing the total cash match to \$8,900,000 for the Project; and authorize the County Administrative Officer, Director of Public Works, and Sheriff to take other actions as necessary to meet State requirements for design as defined under AB 900 Phase II funding.
11/14/2013	BSCC Board conditionally awarded \$43,705,000 to County.
11/05/2013	BOS approved acceptance of \$43,705,000 additional conditional funding when approved by BSCC Board which increased Project from 288 to 576 medium-security-bed facility based on State conditional award of \$80 Million; approved additional \$4,867,222 minimum matching funds to the previously approved match of \$4,032,778, for total cash match of \$8,900,000; and Board Resolution No. 13-339 authorizing award of Architectural/Engineering for Jail Housing Addition to Lionakis for 288 medium-security-bed facility Project.
10/08/2013	SB365 enacted moving AB 900 Phase I funding to AB 900 Phase II; Monterey County's conditional award increased from \$36,295,000 to full \$80 Million conditional award.
09/12/2013	BSCC accepted County's Amended Application with revised scope
08/28/2012	BOS authorized Jail Housing Addition Project (8819), an expansion of 288 medium-security beds with essential administrative and support space improvements, and directed staff to begin process of public outreach, environmental clearance, design, and preparation of construction documents.
08/09/2012	County submitted to BSCC an Amended Application consistent with new conditional award to revise Project scope
07/26/2012	BSCC (formerly CSA) approved conditional funding award of \$36,295,000 toward a \$40,327,778 expansion of Monterey County Adult Jail.
03/08/2012	Corrections Standards Authority found County Application worthy of funding at their Board Meeting; Monterey County ranking fourth, however, received no funding award.
02/13/2012	Kitchell Architectural Consultants provided a project manager with extensive correctional background experience to augment staff's efforts to manage Jail Housing Addition and New Juvenile Hall projects.
12/06/2011	BOS Resolution No. 11-377 approved authorizing Sheriff Miller to sign and submit an application for a local adult detention facility AB 900 construction grant of \$80 Million.
