Approve and authorize the County Counsel to execute Amendment No. 8 to Agreement A-13173 with Foley & Lardner, LLP, for independent consulting and legal services for the Health Department, increasing the total Agreement by \$435,000 for a total Agreement liability not to exceed \$1,665,000, with no change to the existing term of May 1, 2016 through June 30, 2027; and

b. Approve and authorize the County Counsel to execute one future amendment to this Agreement that does not significantly change the scope of work and does not exceed 10% (\$30,000) of the initial agreement amount, for a total revised Agreement liability of \$1,695,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors:

a. Approve and authorize the County Counsel to execute Amendment No. 8 to Agreement A-13173 with Foley & Lardner, LLP, for independent consulting and legal services for the Health Department, increasing the total Agreement by \$435,000 for a total Agreement liability not to exceed \$1,665,000, with no change to the existing term of May 1, 2016 through June 30, 2027; and

b. Approve and authorize the County Counsel to execute one future amendment to this Agreement that does not significantly change the scope of work and does not exceed 10% (\$30,000) of the initial agreement amount, for a total revised Agreement liability of \$1,695,000.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Foley & Lardner specialize in healthcare law providing advice, in consultation with the office of County Counsel, on a variety of healthcare-related issues. The firm's expertise assists the County of Monterey, on the Health Department's behalf, in matters of public healthcare law, including Medi-Cal funding, Medicaid financing for safety net providers, healthcare transactions, provider agreements, technology, privacy and security matters of significant importance to the Health Department.

While this work is not directly in support of a Health Department Strategic goal, it is in support of one or more of the ten essential public health services, specifically: 5. Develop policies and plans that support individual and community health efforts, and 6. Enforce laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
