### INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION ACT AGREEMENT

### 1. PARTIES AND PURPOSE.

This agreement is between the County of Monterey and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) through which the County of Monterey will pay the USGS to provide the following specialized or technical services: participation on a technical advisory committee for the Salinas River Groundwater Basin (SRGB) Investigation.

#### 2. AUTHORITY.

The authorities for the parties to enter into this agreement is the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 31 U.S.C. § 6505. The authority for the USGS to enter into this agreement without advance payment is 43 U.S.C. § 50b.

### 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

- (a) Term of the Project. This agreement is effective as of the date of the last approval signature (see clause 9) through April 1, 2019.
- (b) Statement of Work/Deliverables. Deliverables for this project shall include participation at monthly meetings of the SRGB technical advisory committee; review of progress on model selection and calibration; and evaluation of opportunities for further technical development or contributions which may arise during the model development, calibration, or implementation process.
- (c) Cost. The total cost for the USGS to provide the requested goods and services is \$21,786.00.
- (d) Availability of Information/Data. Each Party shall be entitled to use, publish, and disseminate any scientific or technical information generated by the work performed through this agreement.
- 4. **TRANSFER OF FUNDS**. The County of Monterey will pay for the USGS services based on invoices issued monthly by the USGS. Payments of bills are due within 60 days after the billing date. If not paid by the due date, interest will be charged at the current Treasury rate for each 30 day period, or portion thereof, that the payment is delayed beyond the due date.
- 5. **OMB CIRCULAR A-97 CERTIFICATION**. As required by OMB Circular No. A-97, the County of Monterey certifies that the services being requested pursuant to this agreement cannot be procured reasonably and expeditiously by it through ordinary business channels.

If agreement on interpretation is not reached within 30 days, the parties shall forward the written presentation of the disagreement to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution.
