AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 12.28.010 OF THE MONTEREY COUNTY CODE RELATING TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS		
County Counsel Summary		
This ordinance amends section 12.28.010 of the Monterey County Code to implement a no parking restriction on the north side of Inter-Garrison Road from the centerline of Sherman Boulevard, westerly to a point 500 feet east of the centerline of Abrams Drive (MP1.50), located in the former Fort Ord area in the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey.		
The Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey ordains as follows:		
SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS. Pursuant to Article XI of the California Constitution, the County of Monterey may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes the County of Monterey to enact regulations by ordinance to prohibit or restrict parking of vehicles on certain streets and highways. Board of Supervisors' Resolution No. 13-220, adopted on July 16, 2013, authorized the County Director of Public Works to reopen a segment of Intergarrison Road to vehicular access after approved traffic controls are in place, including parking restrictions on Inter-Garrison Road.		
SECTION 2. Section 12.28.010 of the Monterey County Code is amended to add the following paragraph:		
Inter-Garrison Road. On the north side of Inter-Garrison Road from the centerline of Sherman Boulevard, westerly to a point 500 feet east of the centerline of Abrams Drive (MP 1.50).		
SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption.
