Resolution No.: 26-205

Conduct a public hearing to collect delinquent fees for solid waste collection and:

- a. Accept the report of delinquent fees, as indicated in the “Report of 2025 Delinquent Waste Hauling Fees in the Unincorporated Area” from USA Waste of California, Inc. DBA Carmel Marina Corporation for solid waste hauling fees; and
- b. Consider any objections or protests of landowners liable to be assessed for delinquent fees, as indicated in the report; and
- c. Adopt a resolution to:
 - i. Confirm the report of delinquent solid waste hauling fees for the unincorporated area as identified in the “Report of 2025 Delinquent Waste Hauling Fees in the Unincorporated Area” from USA Waste of California, Inc. DBA Carmel Marina Corporation; and
 - ii. Authorize the delinquent solid waste hauling fees, as set forth in the confirmed report and following conclusion of the dispute resolution process, to constitute special assessments against the respective parcels of land to be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ordinary County ad valorem property taxes are collected; and
 - iii. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to file a certified copy of the report with the Auditor-Controller’s Office
 - iv. Authorize and direct County staff to take any and all such necessary further steps to effectuate the same.

WHEREAS, on June 23, 2026, pursuant to Government Code section 25831, the Board of Supervisors (Board) of the County of Monterey (County) conducted a duly noticed Public Hearing to Collect Delinquent Fees for Solid Waste Collection, as shown on the Report of 2025 Delinquent Waste Hauling Fees in the Unincorporated Area (Attachment A, incorporated herein) which are due and owing under the Unified Franchise Agreement between the County and Waste Management, Inc. DBA Carmel Marina Corporation (Waste Management), who provides the required services in the Unincorporated area of the County; and

WHEREAS, following that Public Hearing, and the Board’s consideration of objections or protests of landowners liable to be assessed for the delinquent fees, and any revisions or corrections to said report as directed by the Board; the Board hereby adopts staff’s recommendations as indicated below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey, hereby takes the following actions as set forth below:

1. Confirms the report of delinquent solid waste hauling fees for the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey as identified in the “Report of 2025 Delinquent Waste Hauling Fees in the Unincorporated Area” from USA Waste of California, Inc. DBA Carmel Marina Corporation; and

2. Authorizes the delinquent solid waste hauling fees, as set forth in the confirmed report and following conclusion of the dispute resolution process, to constitute special assessments against the respective parcels of land to be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ordinary County ad valorem property taxes are collected; and
3. Authorizes the Clerk of the Board to file a certified copy of the report with the Auditor-Controller's Office; and
4. Authorizes and directs County staff to take any and all such necessary further steps to effectuate the same.

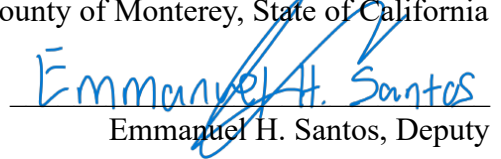
