

Monterey County Board of Supervisors

Board Order

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Upon motion of Supervisor Potter, seconded by Supervisor Armenta and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Received the results of the Toro Area Community survey in support of the formation of a community services district to provide sewer services;
- b. Supported directing staff to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the County of Monterey and the Monterey Regional Water Pollution Control Agency (MRWPCA) for the preparation of a Focused Wastewater Service Area Study that will provide a current assessment of regional opportunities for sewer service area consolidation, including a Basis of Design for infrastructure to serve the Toro Area;
- c. Supported funding of the Focused Wastewater Service Area Study with \$125,000 from the Resource Management Agency Facilities Maintenance Projects Fund (RMA004-401-3000-8184); and
- d. Supported a request by the Board to the Local Area Formation Commission (LAFCO) to provide an opinion on the possible formation of an independent Community Services District (CSD) to take ownership of the wastewater system that currently serves the Toro Community.
