#### ADDITIONAL LUAC COMMENTS

LUAC recommends changing the speed limit from 55 to 45 on Highway 1 near Deetjens to conform to the current 45 mpg speed limit in the "commercial corridor" starting at about mile marker 50 just north of Captain Cooper School ending at mile marker 43. This would provide safer limits to include concerns at Nepenthe and the Henry Miller Library to just south of Deetjens. This would allow the use of shorter crash Cushions at both openings at Deetjens and would better meet the required opening size for fire vehicles to Access 4 guest units only accessible via the southern opening.
