RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors:

- a. Approve Plans and Special Provisions for the Slurry Seal 2012 Project, Contract No. 12-551222; and
- b. Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise the “Notice to Bidders” in *The Californian*.

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

Approval of the Plans and Special Provisions to the Standard Specifications will authorize the Department of Public Works to proceed with advertising for the Slurry Seal 2012 Project, Contract No. 12-551222 (Project). The bid opening is set for March 5, 2012, at 2:00 p.m., in the Board of Supervisors’ Conference Room 1032, Monterey County Government Center, 168 West Alisal Street, 1st Floor, Salinas, CA 93901. Project construction is estimated to begin in early 2012.

The Project consists of application of slurry mix coating on aged asphalt concrete surfaces on roads around Country Meadows Subdivision, Bolsa Nueva Subdivision (Oak Hills), Toro Hills Estate (Portola Area) and CSA 25. The Project will provide a much needed pavement maintenance for approximately 8 miles of roads in the San Miguel Maintenance District and approximately 8.5 miles in the Monterey Maintenance District. These roads have not received treatment since 2001. The proposed project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA guidelines Section 15301(c).


OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Office of the County Counsel, Auditor-Controller, and Risk Management have reviewed and approved the Special Provisions as to form, fiscal provisions, and insurance indemnity/language, respectively.



FINANCING:

Total estimated project cost, including project management, engineering, and construction, is \$699,620. Approximately 98.5% (\$689,480) of the Project is funded by the General Fund contribution to the Road Fund while 1.5% (\$10,140) is funded by CSA 25. There are sufficient appropriations in the Department of Public Works Road Fund (Fund 002, Unit 8195) to finance this Project.
