WHEREAS federal law requires that each County eligible to receive 2013 Secure Rural Schools and Communities Act (SRSCA) funding must, by December 31, 2013, elect to receive SRSCA funds or elect to receive their 2013 share of the 25% Actual Forest receipts from National Forest lands; and

WHEREAS federal law requires that those Counties electing to receive \$100,000 or more of SRSCA funding in 2013, must elect to set aside 15% or 20% of those funds for Title II and/or Title III Projects; and

WHEREAS federal law further requires that each County must designate the percentage of those project funds assigned to Title II and Title III for 2013, recognizing that a maximum of 7% can be expended for Title III.

WHEREAS federal law also requires that those Counties whose election of SRSCA funds amounts to less than \$100,000 must also elect to use 100% of such funds for public roads and schools under Title I of the SRSCA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey in the State of California does hereby elect to receive 2013 SRSCA funds in an amount that is less than \$100,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby elect to use 100-percent of its 2013 Secure Rural Schools and Communities Act Funds for public roads and schools under Title I of the SRSCA.
