This First Amendment is made and entered into by and between The Regents of the University of California, a California Constitutional corporation, on behalf of the University of California, San Francisco, School of Medicine, Department of Family and Community Medicine (hereinafter referred to as "School"), and County of Monterey d/b/a Natividad Medical Center, an acute care hospital owned and operated by County of Monterey (hereinafter referred to as "Affiliate").

## **RECITALS:**

**WHEREAS**, School and Affiliate have heretofore entered into an "Affiliation Agreement for Family Medicine Residency Program Between The Regents of the University of California By and On Behalf of its University of California, San Francisco School of Medicine And Natividad Medical Center, an acute care hospital owned and operated by County of Monterey" for the term beginning November 1, 2012 and ending October 21, 2017 ("**Agreement**"); and

WHEREAS, School and Affiliate, per Agreement Section XIX, <u>Modifications and Amendments</u>, wish to amend the Agreement as further set forth below;

NOW THEREFORE, School and Affiliate hereby agree to amend the Agreement, as follows:

- 1. Section XV, <u>Assignment</u>, shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety as follows:
  - "Neither AFFILIATE nor SCHOOL shall assign their rights, duties, or obligations under this Agreement, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the other; provided, however, that AFFILIATE may assign TRAINEES to locations other than those described in Section II.A. without the prior written consent of SCHOOL."
- 2. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and unaffected by this First Amendment and shall continue in full force and effect.
- 3. The effective date of this First Amendment is October 16, 2015.
