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Board Order

Upon motion of Supervisor Salinas, seconded by Supervisor Armenta, and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Approved and adopted the Monterey County Local Preference Policy as presented by the Resource Management Agency and the Contracts/Purchasing Division in response to Board Referral 2011.08; and
- b. Approved supporting staff's recommendation of Option-A:
In the procurement of goods or services in which price is the determining factor for award of the contract, a five percent (5%) preference shall be subtracted from a bid submitted by a responsive local vendor in determining the lowest responsive bidder. If application of the 5% results in a local vendor's bid being at or lower than the non-local vendor, the contract award shall be made to the local vendor at the local vendors bid price, as currently defined by County Ordinance 2.32.035 Preference for Local Suppliers.
