RECITALS:

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2019, per Resolution No. 19-419, the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors authorized the Emergency Services Manager from the County of Monterey Office of Emergency Services to execute an Agreement with CalOES for the Resiliency Allocation of FY 2019 PSPS funds in the amount of \$464,903 with a performance period of July 1, 2019, through October 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in September 2022, CalOES granted an extension of the performance period for FY 2019 PSPS funds to December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Office of Emergency Services was reorganized into the Department of Emergency Management in December 2022, and an update reflecting that reorganization is required by CalOES in order to maintain continuity of grant management and to administratively close out the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Management requests that the position titles of Director of Emergency Management and Emergency Services Manager be designated as authorized agents to interact with, manage, and administratively close out the CalOES Resiliency Allocation of FY 2019 PSPS funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey, State of California, as follows:

- a. Director of Emergency Management and Emergency Services Manager are designated and authorized to execute and manage grant documents for the CalOES Resiliency Allocation of FY 2019 PSPS funds.
