Per a recent assessment of a proposed well drilling site located on the parcel at 264 Paradise Road in Salinas (APN: 129-096-004), it has been determined that sensitive habitat and/or protected special status species will not be impacted by project related activities (refer to the attached photo). This well site is located in a non-native eucalyptus woodland, and native specie trees and/or protected flora or fauna were not observed and are not occurring within or adjacent to this small project footprint. Consequently, other than the proper installation and maintenance of erosion and sedimentation control measures that may be needed, there is no indication or concern that sensitive habitat and/or flora and fauna that have protection status will be disturbed or impacted by project operations.
