

**AMENDMENT NO. 3  
TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND  
CONSOR NORTH AMERICA, INC.**

**THIS AMENDMENT NO. 3** to Professional Services Agreement No. A-15150 between the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter, “County”) and CONSOR North America, Inc. (hereinafter, “CONTRACTOR”) is hereby entered into between the County and the CONTRACTOR (collectively, the “Parties”) and effective as of the last date opposite the respective signatures below.

**WHEREAS**, County entered into Professional Services Agreement No. A-15150 with CONTRACTOR’s predecessor, Quincy Engineering, Inc., on April 1, 2021 (hereinafter, “Agreement”) to provide professional engineering design services (hereinafter, “services”) for the Palo Colorado Road Repair Project from milepost 4.0 to 7.8, Project No. 6210, Request for Proposals (RFP) #10766, (hereinafter, “Project”) through April 1, 2024, with the option to extend the Agreement for two (2) additional one (1) year period(s), for an amount not to exceed \$1,605,000; and

**WHEREAS**, Agreement was amended by the Parties on March 14, 2024 (hereinafter, “Amendment No. 1”) to update various provisions and to extend the term for one (1) additional year through April 1, 2025 with no increase in the not to exceed amount; and

**WHEREAS**, Agreement was amended by the Parties on July 17, 2024 (hereinafter, “Amendment No. 2”, including Exhibit A-1 - Scope of Services/Payment Provisions) to update the CONTRACTOR’s hourly rates effective July 17, 2024, update various provisions, extend the term for one (1) additional year through April 1, 2026, and to increase the amount by \$249,900 which resulted in a total not to exceed amount of \$1,854,900; and

**WHEREAS**, various provisions of the Agreement require an update; and

**WHEREAS**, Phase 1A of the Project has been completed and Phase 1B of the Project is approximately 95% complete; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree that the CONTRACTOR’s hourly rates in Exhibit A-1, Scope of Services/Payment Provisions of the Agreement remain valid through April 1, 2031; and

**WHEREAS**, the storm damage portion of the Project is partially funded by California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with FEMA funding requirements, the County’s Board of Supervisors adopted an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Project on March 19, 2024, pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and submitted the documentation to CalOES on October 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, CalOES reviewed the documentation and forwarded it to FEMA on January 16, 2025, and FEMA is responsible for completing the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Environmental Assessment (EA); and

**WHEREAS**, FEMA's review and approval process for the NEPA environmental documentation has taken more than one (1) year, and the review and approval has not yet been completed, resulting in Project delays; and

**WHEREAS**, additional time is necessary to allow CONTRACTOR to continue to provide the services required by the County for completion of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to further amend the Agreement to update various provisions and to extend the term for five (5) additional years to April 1, 2031 with no associated dollar amount increase to allow CONTRACTOR to continue to provide services identified in the Agreement and as amended by this Amendment No. 3.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend the first sentence of Paragraph 3, "Term of Agreement", to read as follows:

The term of this Agreement is from April 1, 2021, to April 1, 2031, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

2. Amend the "Auto Liability Coverage" paragraph under Section 9.03, "Insurance Coverage Requirements", of Paragraph 9.0, "Insurance", to read as follows:

Auto Liability Coverage: must include motor vehicles, including scheduled, non-owned, and hired vehicles, used in providing services under this Agreement, with a combined single limit or Bodily Injury and Property Damage of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

*(Note: any proposed modifications to these auto insurance requirements shall be attached as an Exhibit hereto, and the section(s) above that are proposed as not applicable shall be lined out in blue ink. All proposed modifications are subject to County approval.)*

3. Amend Section 9.04, "Other Insurance Requirements", of Paragraph 9.0, "Insurance", to read as follows:

All insurance required by this Agreement shall be with a company acceptable to the County and issued and executed by an admitted insurer authorized to transact Insurance business in the State of California. Unless otherwise specified by this Agreement, all such insurance shall be written on an occurrence basis, or, if the policy is not written on an occurrence

basis, such policy with the coverage required herein shall continue in effect for a period of three years following the date CONTRACTOR completes its performance of services under this Agreement.

Each liability policy shall provide that the County shall be given notice in writing at least thirty days in advance of any endorsed reduction in coverage or limit, cancellation, or intended non-renewal thereof. Each policy shall provide coverage for CONTRACTOR and additional insureds with respect to claims arising from each subcontractor, if any, performing work under this Agreement, or be accompanied by a certificate of insurance from each subcontractor showing each subcontractor has identical insurance coverage to the above requirements.

Additional Insured Status:

The County of Monterey, its officers, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds on the auto liability policy for liability arising out of automobiles owned, leased, hired or borrowed by or on behalf of the CONTRACTOR. Auto liability coverage shall be provided in the form of an endorsement to the CONTRACTOR's insurance.

The County of Monterey, its officers, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers are to be covered as additional insureds on the commercial general liability policy with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of the CONTRACTOR including materials, parts, or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations. General liability coverage shall be provided in the form of an endorsement to the CONTRACTOR's insurance (at least as broad as ISO Form CG 20 10 11 85 or if not available, through the addition of both CG 20 10, CG 20 26, CG 20 33, or CG 20 38; and CG 20 37 if a later edition is used).

Primary Coverage:

For any claims related to this Agreement, the CONTRACTOR's insurance coverage shall be primary and non-contributory and at least as broad as ISO CG 20 01 04 13 as respects to the County, its officers, officials, employees, agents, and volunteers. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the County, its officers, officials, employees, agents, or volunteers shall be excess of the CONTRACTOR's insurance and shall not contribute with it. This requirement shall also apply to any Excess or Umbrella liability policies.

Workers' Compensation Insurance Waiver of Subrogation:

The Workers' Compensation Insurance policy required hereunder shall be endorsed to state that the Workers' Compensation Insurance carrier waives its right of subrogation against COUNTY, its officers, officials, employees, agents, or volunteers, which might arise by reason of payment under such policy in connection with performance under this Agreement by CONTRACTOR. Should CONTRACTOR be self-insured for Workers' Compensation Insurance, CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to waive its right of subrogation against COUNTY, its officers, officials, employees, agents, or volunteers.

Prior to the execution of this Agreement by the County, CONTRACTOR shall file certificates of insurance and endorsements with the County's Contract Administrator and County's Contracts/Purchasing Division, showing that the CONTRACTOR has in effect the insurance required by this Agreement. The CONTRACTOR shall file a new or amended certificate of insurance within five (5) calendar days after any change is made in any insurance policy, which would alter the information on the certificate then on file. Acceptance or approval of insurance shall in no way modify or change the indemnification clause in this Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect. CONTRACTOR shall always during the term of this Agreement maintain in force the insurance coverage required under this Agreement and shall send, without demand by County, annual certificates to County's Contract Administrator and County's Contracts/Purchasing Division. If the certificate is not received by the expiration date, County shall notify CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR shall have five calendar days to send in the certificate, evidencing no lapse in coverage during the interim. Failure by CONTRACTOR to maintain such insurance is a default of this Agreement, which entitles County, at its sole discretion, to terminate this Agreement immediately.

4. Amend Paragraph 10, "Records and Confidentiality", to add Section 10.06, "Format of Deliverables", as follows:

For this section, "Deliverables" shall mean all electronic documents CONTRACTOR provides to the County under this Agreement. CONTRACTOR shall ensure all Deliverables comply with the requirements of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines ("WCAG") 2.1, pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA"). CONTRACTOR bears the burden to deliver Deliverables, such as Adobe Acrobat Portable Document Format ("PDF") and Microsoft Office files, complying with WCAG 2.1. CONTRACTOR shall defend and indemnify the County against any breach of this Section. This Section shall survive the termination of this Agreement. Find more on Accessibility at this State website: <https://webstandards.ca.gov/accessibility/>.

5. Amend Agreement to add Section 15.18, "Independent Contractor Compliance with Government Code Section 1097.6(c)", under Paragraph 15, "Miscellaneous Provisions", as follows:

This section applies to those situations when a CONTRACTOR is awarded an Agreement for a preliminary phase of a project, with future phases to be bid separately. This section does not apply to those situations when an Agreement is awarded for multiple phases of a project under a single Agreement/proposal. When applicable, and as described below, CONTRACTOR's duties and services under this Agreement shall not include preparing or assisting the public entity with any portion of the public entity's preparation of a request for proposals, request for qualifications, or any other solicitation regarding a subsequent or additional contract with the public entity. The public entity entering this Agreement shall at all times retain responsibility for public contracting, including with respect to any subsequent phase of this project. CONTRACTOR's participation in the planning, discussions, or drawing of project plans or specifications shall be limited to conceptual,

preliminary, or initial plans or specifications. CONTRACTOR shall cooperate with the public entity to ensure that all bidders for a subsequent contract on any subsequent phase of this project have access to the same information, including all conceptual, preliminary, or initial plans or specifications prepared by CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement.

6. The “Project Schedule” referenced in the Agreement, Exhibit A – Scope of Services/Payment Provisions, is hereby amended to extend through April 1, 2031, to conform to the amended term of the Agreement.
7. In all places within the Agreement, any reference to the County’s Travel Policy website address of <https://www.co.monterey.ca.us/home/showdocument?id=69364>, is hereby replaced with <https://www.countyofmonterey.gov/home/showdocument?id=69364>.
8. In all places within the Agreement, any reference to County’s email address of [PWFP-Finance-AP@co.monterey.ca.us](mailto:PWFP-Finance-AP@co.monterey.ca.us) for invoicing, is hereby replaced with [PWFP-Finance-AP@countyofmonterey.gov](mailto:PWFP-Finance-AP@countyofmonterey.gov).
9. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement, including all Exhibits thereto, remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
10. This Amendment No. 3 and all previous amendments shall be attached to the Agreement and incorporated therein as if fully set forth in the Agreement.
11. The recitals to this Amendment No. 3 are incorporated into the Agreement and this Amendment No. 3.

**I. LIABILITY COVERAGE**

**A. Who Is An Insured**

1. a. Any incorporated entity of which the Named Insured owns a majority of the voting stock on the date of inception of this Coverage Form; **provided that,**
  - b. The insurance afforded by this provision **A.1.** does not apply to any such entity that is an **insured** under any other liability "policy" providing **auto** coverage.
2. Any organization you newly acquire or form, other than a limited liability company, partnership or joint venture, and over which you maintain majority ownership interest.

The insurance afforded by this provision **A.2.:**

- a. Is effective on the acquisition or formation date, and is afforded only until the end of the policy period of this Coverage Form, or the next anniversary of its inception date, whichever is earlier.
- b. Does not apply to:
  - (1) **Bodily injury or property damage** caused by an **accident** that occurred before you acquired or formed the organization; or
  - (2) Any such organization that is an **insured** under any other liability "policy" providing **auto** coverage.
3. Any person or organization that you are obligated to provide Insurance where required by a written contract or agreement is an insured, but only with respect to legal responsibility for acts or omissions of a person for whom Liability Coverage is afforded under this policy.
4. An **employee** of yours is an **insured** while operating an **auto** hired or rented under a contract or agreement in that **employee's** name, with your permission, while performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

"Policy", as used in this provision **A. Who Is An Insured**, includes those policies that were in force on the inception date of this Coverage Form but:

1. Which are no longer in force; or
2. Whose limits have been exhausted.

**B. Bail Bonds and Loss of Earnings**

**SECTION II, Paragraphs A.2.a.(2) and A.2.a.(4)** are revised as follows:

1. In **a.(2)**, the limit for the cost of bail bonds is increased from \$2,000 to \$5,000, and
2. In **a.(4)**, the limit for the loss of earnings is increased from \$250 to \$500 a day.

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

**COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY COVERAGE PART**

It is understood and agreed as follows:

- I. **WHO IS AN INSURED** is amended to include as an **Insured** any person or organization whom you are required by **written contract** to add as an additional insured on this **Coverage Part**, but only with respect to liability for **bodily injury, property damage or personal and advertising injury** caused in whole or in part by your acts or omissions, or the acts or omissions of those acting on your behalf:
- A. In the performance of your ongoing operations subject to such **written contract**; or
  - B. In the performance of **your work** subject to such **written contract**, but only with respect to **bodily injury or property damage** included in the **products-completed operations hazard**, and only if:
    - 1. The **written contract** requires you to provide the additional insured such coverage; and
    - 2. This **Coverage Part** provides such coverage; and
  - C. Subject always to the terms and conditions of this policy, including the limits of insurance, the Insurer will not provide such additional insured with:
    - 1. Coverage broader than what you are required to provide by the **written contract**; or
    - 2. A higher limit of insurance than what you are required to provide by the **written contract**.

Any coverage granted by this Paragraph I. shall apply solely to the extent permissible by law.

- II. If the written contract requires additional insured coverage under the 07-04 edition of CG2010 or CG2037, then paragraph I. above is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

**WHO IS AN INSURED** is amended to include as an **Insured** any person or organization whom you are required by **written contract** to add as an additional insured on this **Coverage Part**, but only with respect to liability for **bodily injury, property damage or personal and advertising injury** caused in whole or in part by your acts or omissions, or the acts or omissions of those acting on your behalf:

- A. In the performance of your ongoing operations subject to such **written contract**; or
- B. In the performance of **your work** subject to such **written contract**, but only with respect to **bodily injury or property damage** included in the **products-completed operations hazard**, and only if:
  - 1. The **written contract** requires you to provide the additional insured such coverage; and
  - 2. This **Coverage Part** provides such coverage.

- III. But if the **written contract** requires:

- A. Additional insured coverage under the 11-85 edition, 10-93 edition, or 10-01 edition of CG2010, or under the 10-01 edition of CG2037; or
- B. Additional insured coverage with "arising out of" language;

then paragraph I. above is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

**WHO IS AN INSURED** is amended to include as an **Insured** any person or organization whom you are required by **written contract** to add as an additional insured on this **Coverage Part**, but only with respect to liability for **bodily injury, property damage or personal and advertising injury** arising out of **your work** that is subject to such **written contract**.

IV. But if the **written contract** requires additional insured coverage to the greatest extent permissible by law, then paragraph I. above is deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

**WHO IS AN INSURED** is amended to include as an **Insured** any person or organization whom you are required by **written contract** to add as an additional insured on this **Coverage Part**, but only with respect to liability for **bodily injury, property damage** or **personal and advertising injury** arising out of **your work** that is subject to such **written contract**.

V. The insurance granted by this endorsement to the additional insured does not apply to **bodily injury, property damage, or personal and advertising injury** arising out of:

A. The rendering of, or the failure to render, any professional architectural, engineering, or surveying services, including:

1. The preparing, approving, or failing to prepare or approve maps, shop drawings, opinions, reports, surveys, field orders, change orders or drawings and specifications; and
2. Supervisory, inspection, architectural or engineering activities; or

B. Any premises or work for which the additional insured is specifically listed as an additional insured on another endorsement attached to this **Coverage Part**.

VI. Under **COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY CONDITIONS**, the Condition entitled **Other Insurance** is amended to add the following, which supersedes any provision to the contrary in this Condition or elsewhere in this **Coverage Part**:

**Primary and Noncontributory Insurance**

With respect to other insurance available to the additional insured under which the additional insured is a named insured, this insurance is primary to and will not seek contribution from such other insurance, provided that a **written contract** requires the insurance provided by this policy to be:

1. Primary and non-contributing with other insurance available to the additional insured; or
2. Primary and to not seek contribution from any other insurance available to the additional insured.

But except as specified above, this insurance will be excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured.

VII. Solely with respect to the insurance granted by this endorsement, the section entitled **COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY CONDITIONS** is amended as follows:

The Condition entitled **Duties In The Event of Occurrence, Offense, Claim or Suit** is amended with the addition of the following:

Any additional insured pursuant to this endorsement will as soon as practicable:

1. Give the Insurer written notice of any **claim**, or any **occurrence** or offense which may result in a **claim**;
2. Send the Insurer copies of all legal papers received, and otherwise cooperate with the Insurer in the investigation, defense, or settlement of the **claim**; and
3. Make available any other insurance, and endeavor to tender the defense and indemnity of any **claim** to any other insurer or self-insurer, whose policy or program applies to a loss that the Insurer covers under this **coverage part**. However, if the **written contract** requires this insurance to be primary and non-contributory, this paragraph 3. does not apply to other insurance under which the additional insured is a named insured.

The Insurer has no duty to defend or indemnify an additional insured under this endorsement until the Insurer receives written notice of a **claim** from the additional insured.

VIII. Solely with respect to the insurance granted by this endorsement, the section entitled **DEFINITIONS** is amended to add the following definition:

**Written contract** means a written contract or written agreement that requires you to make a person or organization an additional insured on this **Coverage Part**, provided the contract or agreement:

- A. Was executed prior to:
  - 1. The **bodily injury** or **property damage**; or
  - 2. The offense that caused the **personal and advertising injury**;  
for which the additional insured seeks coverage; and
