 The purposes for which the fees have been collected are identified in Exhibit A attached hereto; A reasonable relationship exists between the fees and the purposes for which they were charged; The sources and amounts of funding anticipated to complete the financing of the various improvements identified in Exhibit B; and The approximate dates on which the funding are identified in Exhibit B.
