

## Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP)

### **Five-Year CIP**

- Includes projects that:
  - \$100,000+
  - Provide long-term assets
  - Maintain and/or improve the County's infrastructure
- Budget and a Plan:
  - Budget: Year 1 is financially constrained and will become part of the annual operating budget when approved.
  - Plan: Years 2 through 5 are a plan of priorities.
- Updated annually based on current priorities and funding.

# CIP Development



**Project Updates** 

#### December to February

Departments provide updates to existing CIP projects and submit new requests.



Budget Committee

#### March:

BC reviews draft CIP and comments on funding recommendations.



Budget Development

#### Apr-May

CAO Budget Office may allocate available funding to priority projects in recommended budget.



**Budget Adoption** 

#### June

Board adopts budget and CIP.

#### March

CIC reviews draft CIP and makes recommendations to the Board on unfunded project priorities.



### April

Board reviews unfunded project requests and CIC recommendations, provides any direction to CAO Budget Office.



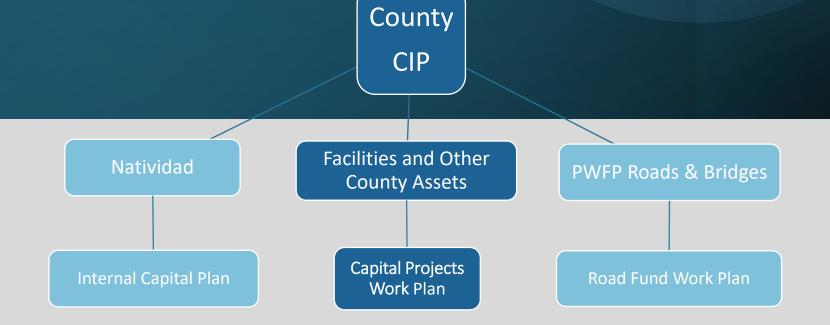
