JULY 19 & 20, 2013 AS "MDA DAYS" )

**WHEREAS**, Muscular Dystrophy refers to a group of more than 43 neuromuscular diseases that caused generalized weakness and muscle wasting; two of the most common neuromuscular diseases include Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy, a disease found in children that progresses slowly, with survival rare beyond their late twenties, and Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (Lou Gehrig's Disease) a disorder that progresses rapidly in adults; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Muscular Dystrophy Association is a dedicated partnership of scientists and citizens aimed at conquering neuromuscular diseases. MDA is one of the world's leading national health agencies, with seventy-seven percent of every dollar raised funding research, patient care, summer camp, and education; and,
