WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Sievers was born in Yankton, South Dakota, and was raised, along with his sister, Melissa, by his parents, Terry and Bonnie Sievers, while the family was stationed at several Army bases around the world; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Sievers was hired by the Monterey County Sheriff's Office in October 2002 as a Deputy Recruit, graduating from the police academy in April 2003; and

WHEREAS, upon graduating from the police academy, **Sergeant Mark Sievers** received the Oath of Office from Sheriff Mike Kanalakis on April 25, 2003, and throughout his distinguished career served under Sheriff Gordon Sonne, Sheriff Mike Kanalakis, Sheriff Scott Miller, Sheriff Steve Bernal, and Sheriff Tina Nieto; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Sievers began his career in the Corrections Operations Bureau and was assigned to the Transportation Unit; and in 2005 transferred to the Patrol Division, where he served as a Patrol Deputy; and from 2010 to 2014 was assigned to the County of Monterey Marijuana Eradication Team (COMMET), during which time he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant by Sheriff Scott Miller; and

WHEREAS, from 2006 to 2019, during his service in the Operations Division, **Sergeant Mark Sievers** served as a member of the Sheriff's Office Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team, contributing his skills, leadership, and professionalism to one of the agency's most demanding assignments; and

WHEREAS, from 2016 to 2020, **Sergeant Mark Sievers** was assigned to the Professional Standards Unit, where he upheld the integrity, accountability, and high ethical expectations of the Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Sievers has expressed that one of the greatest privileges of his career was the opportunity to work alongside many of the finest law enforcement professionals within the Monterey County Sheriff's Office and partner agencies, and he considers it an honor to have served the residents of Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Mark Sievers and his wife, Deanna, share two children together, in addition to his daughter, all of whom have supported him throughout his years of dedicated public service.
