AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADDING SECTION 12.28.075 TO THE MONTEREY COUNTY CODE RELATING TO TIME-LIMITED PARKING ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS

## **County Counsel Summary**

This ordinance adds section 12.28.075 to the Monterey County Code to establish a 30-minute parking zone between eight a.m. and five p.m. on a portion of Porter Drive in the community of Pajaro, in the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS. Pursuant to Article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Monterey may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. Pursuant to California Vehicle Code section 22507 (a), the County of Monterey may, by ordinance or resolution, prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles, including, but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height within 100 feet of any intersection, on certain streets or highways, or portions thereof, during all or certain hours of the day.

SECTION 2. Section 12.28.075 is added to the Monterey County Code to read as follows:

## 12.28.075 PARKING-THIRTY MINUTE LIMIT.

No person shall park any vehicle for longer than thirty minutes between eight a.m. and five p.m. in any of the following places, and said places shall be indicated by appropriate signs or curb markings:

Porter Drive. On the east side of Porter Drive from a point 545 feet from the southeast curb return of San Juan Road, southerly to the centerline of Salinas Road.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption.
