**WHEREAS**, the American Cancer Fund for Children and Kids Cancer Connection reports that cancer is the leading cause of death by disease among children in the United States between infancy and age fifteen; and

**WHEREAS**, this tragic disease is diagnosed in more than 16,000 young people in the United States each year, and an estimated 400,000 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer worldwide annually; and

**WHEREAS**, one in five children in the United States who are diagnosed with cancer lose their battle with the disease; and

**WHEREAS**, many infants, children, and teenagers who undergo cancer treatment experience long-term side effects, including the development of secondary cancers; and

**WHEREAS**, founded over thirty years ago by Steven Firestein, a member of the philanthropic Max Factor cosmetics family, the American Cancer Fund for Children, Inc., Kids Cancer Connection, Inc., along with Lions Clubs International are dedicated to helping these children and their families; and






