Adopt a resolution recognizing August 31, 2024, as International Overdose

Awareness Day; a day of remembrance of all lives lost or forever changed by drug overdose, with the theme, "Together we can" underscoring the importance of coming together as an international community to create change.....

WHEREAS, following several years of decline, the number of opioid related deaths in Monterey County has increased annually from 7 deaths in 2017 to 31 deaths in 2022; and
