NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County and all its residents, the Department of Social Services, and members of the IHSS Advisory Committee, do hereby proclaim November 2022 as **National Family Caregivers Month** and honor the incredible commitment, dedication, and sacrifice of family caregivers.
