Sealed bids for the above project will be received at OFFICE OF CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS/COUNTY OF MONTEREY/168 W ALISAL ST FL1/SALINAS CA 93901 (Mailing Address: P O Box 1728/Salinas CA 93902-1728) **until the submission deadline: 2:00 p.m.** on Thursday, April 7, 2016, at which time they will be publicly opened and read in the Board of Supervisors' Conference Room.

Only the following Contractors who responded to RFQ 10550, Request for Contractor Prequalification for the New Juvenile Hall, Project 8811, issued on October 8, 2015, and were evaluated and determined qualified and listed on the Prequalified Contractors Eligible to Bid on the Construction Contract for the New Juvenile Hall, Project No. 8811 below are eligible to bid for this construction contract. Interested subcontractors should contact these contractors directly.

Each bid shall be in accordance with the drawings, plans, specifications, and subject to all Special Provisions/Conditions, General Conditions, and other contract documents prepared by the County, and shall be submitted on the bid form prescribed by County. County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening of bids without the written consent of County. The bidder shall possess a valid Class B-General Building Contractor's License at the time of bid opening.

Base Bid consists of new construction of the facility in phases with existing buildings demolished to make way for a new recreation yard and support buildings (See Project Page for full detail of base bid components and six additive/deductive alternates). Upon completion, the 120-bed facility will provide ~63,438 square feet (sf) of total building area and ~100,108 sf of site improvements on ~9.2 acres of county-owned land at 1420 Natividad Road, Salinas, CA. Determination of lowest bidder will be determined by the Base Bid. Architect's Estimate for the base bid elements is \$38,092,591. Work is scheduled to begin in June 2016, with completion in July 2018. **A Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting for all prospective bidders is scheduled at the Project site (1420 Natividad Road, Salinas CA) at 10 a.m. on February 12, 2016. This meeting must be attended in its entirety.**

All questions during bidding period must be submitted, in writing, as follows: via E-mail to Bid Processing Coordinator listed on RMA-PW project page or via postal mail to: Bid #10560 Project Manager/RMA-PW/168 W Alisal St FL2/Salinas CA 93901-2438. **Deadline for receipt of written questions is 10 a.m., March 25, 2016.** No questions will be accepted after the deadline. Answers to all questions and project addenda will be posted to RMA-PW project page listed above.

Security in an amount equal to at least ten percent of the total amount of the bid in the form of cash, cashier's check, or certified check payable to the County, or a bidder's bond in the form attached to the proposal executed by an admitted corporate surety company, must accompany the bid. For the selected contractor, a payment bond and a performance bond, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract, are required.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code section 22300, the Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the County to ensure performance under the contract.

A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code, or engaged in performance of any contract for public work, as defined, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 at the time the contract is awarded.

Bidders must comply with the provisions of Monterey County Code Section 5.08.120, requiring a good-faith effort to employ qualified individuals who are residents of the Monterey Bay Area as defined.

General prevailing wage rates in the county in which the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and are on file and available at RMA-PW/168 W Alisal St FL2/Salinas CA 93901 and DIR Internet website: <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD>. It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under him, to pay not less than said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract. Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR.
