Dear Ms. Silvestri:

This letter serves as formal notice to you that the Housing and Community Development Department of the State of California informed us that your brother, Epie Fresquez, Jr., should be able to continue to reside in the property without triggering repayment of your deceased parent's rehabilitation loan provided he continues to occupy your parent's home and the property remains in your father's Revocable Living Trust.

As a reminder and for your records, the rehabilitation loan your parents received in 2006 was for the amount of \$205,188.00, and is due and payable in 30 years (on July 31, 2036). Payments are deferred for 30 years and interest continues to accrue at 3% on the unpaid balance. The balance of the loan as of October 31, 2012, is \$244,010.69. Pre-payments may be made at any time prior to the due date. If you wish to make payments or set up a schedule of payments in order to keep the outstanding balance from increasing, we would be happy to assist you.
