- a. Adopting an Ordinance adding Section 320 to Chapter 21.64 of the Monterey County Code to establish regulations relating to the issuance of land use permits and entitlements for development utilizing private roads in the inland unincorporated areas of Monterey County; b. Adopting a Resolution of Intent to adopt an ordinance adding Section 320 to Chapter 20.64 of Title 20 (The Coastal Implementation Plan Part 1) of the Monterey County Code to establish regulations relating to the issuance of land use permits and entitlements for development utilizing private roads in the Coastal Zone; and
- c. Finding the actions categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act; and
- d. Directing staff to submit the Resolution of Intent to amend the Coastal Implementation Plan to the California Coastal Commission for certification. (Proof of Access, PLN060127/Inland, REF130084/Coastal, County-wide)
