WHEREAS, the authority to fly certain flags is found in various legal citations, predominately Title 4 of the United States Code (“the Flag Code”), Title 36 of the United States Code (chronicling the dates where the President may or must issue an order to lower the United States Flag), the California Government Code, and the California Military and Veterans Affairs Code; and

WHEREAS, jurisdictions generally adopt a flag policy to place the various flag etiquette requirements in one location; and,

WHEREAS, jurisdictions also adopt a flag policy to determine which body or department may choose to raise a flag other than those indicated in law; and,

WHEREAS, given the County of Monterey does not currently possess such a policy but its inclusion in the Board Policy Manual will serve as direction for facilities throughout the County;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey that the Flag Policy, attached hereto, is approved for inclusion in the Board Policy Manual.


