WHEREAS, the Monterey County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) has received a proposal from the Aromas Water District involving annexation of two parcels in the San Juan Road and Dunbarton Road areas; and

WHEREAS, Revenue and Taxation Code Section 99 requires the Board of Supervisors of Monterey County to determine an appropriate tax transfer for all jurisdictional changes of organization occurring within Monterey County which could affect the service responsibility of any special district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 99(b)(6), the Executive Officer of LAFCO shall not issue a Certificate of Filing (Government Code Section 56828) for a change of organization until an exchange of property tax revenue is negotiated; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Board of Supervisors approved and adopted a formula and policies for determining property tax transfer resulting from jurisdictional changes involving special districts (Resolution No. 80-249); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Board of Supervisors does hereby resolve, determine and order a Zero Property Tax Transfer involving the proposed Aromas Water District annexation of two existing parcels in the San Juan Road and Dunbarton Road area, (APN 141-041-007 and APN 141-001-006)
