Adopt a resolution amending the Juvenile)
Justice Coordinating Council Bylaws)

WHEREAS the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors established the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) on November 12, 1996;

WHEREAS Welfare and Institutions Code 749.22 requires counties to establish a multiagency juvenile justice coordinating council to develop and implement a continuum of county-based responses to juvenile crime, and also establishes the minimal membership for JJCC, with the Chief Probation Officer serving as council Chair for the duration of his or her appointment;

WHEREAS, in compliance with Welfare and Institutions Code 1995, a JJCC subcommittee has been established to develop a plan describing the facilities, programs, placements, services, supervision and reentry strategies that are needed to provide appropriate rehabilitation and supervision services for the in-custody youth realigned to counties from the State Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ); and

WHEREAS the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council adopted revised bylaws with additional language and clarifications on April 21, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Board does hereby amend the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council bylaws as adopted by the JJCC on April 21, 2021.
